9 AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING
10 ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 27.20.110, ESTABLISHING A PUBLIC
11 SAFETY BOARD FOR THE GIRDWOOD VALLEY SERVICE AREA

14 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

16 **Section 1:** That AMC 27.20.110 is amended to read as follows
17

- 18 A There is established a board of supervisors for the Girdwood Valley
19 Service Area consisting of four persons elected in accordance with the
20 provisions of this chapter and one person appointed by the Mayor subject
21 to confirmation by the Assembly. The board shall be constituted and shall
22 function in the manner prescribed in this chapter in the exercise of street
23 construction and maintenance, solid waste collection, and parks and
24 recreation services.
- 25 B. There is established a Public Safety Board for the Girdwood Valley
26 Service Area consisting of five members, three members of which shall
27 also be members of the Girdwood Valley Service Area board of
28 supervisors and two members of which shall not be members of the
29 Girdwood Valley Service Area board of supervisors, all of whom shall be
30 elected in accordance with the provisions of this chapter. The board shall
31 be constituted and shall function in the manner prescribed in this chapter
32 in the exercise of service area fire protection services.
- 33 C. In the event of a vacancy on either board prior to the expiration of a term,
34 the Mayor shall appoint a replacement subject to confirmation by the
35 Assembly.

37 **Section 2:** That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon
38 passage and approval.
