AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING ANCHORAGE
MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 27.20.110, ESTABLISHING A PUBLIC SAFETY BOARD FOR THE
GIRDWOOD VALLEY SERVICE AREA

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1: That AMC 27.20.110 is amended to read as follows:

- A. There is established a board of supervisors for the Girdwood Valley Service Area consisting of five [FOUR] persons elected in accordance with the provisions of this chapter. [AND ONE PERSON APPOINTED BY THE MAYOR SUBJECT TO CONFIRMATION BY THE ASSEMBLY] The board shall be constituted and shall function in the manner prescribed in this chapter in the exercise of street construction and maintenance, solid waste collection, and parks and recreation services.
- B. There is established a Public Safety Board for the Girdwood Valley Service Area consisting of five members, three members of which shall also be members of the Girdwood Valley Service Area Board of supervisors and two members of which shall not be members of the Girdwood Valley Service Area board of supervisors, all of whom shall be elected in accordance with the provisions of this chapter. The board shall be constituted and shall function in the manner prescribed in this chapter in the exercise of service area fire protection services.
- C. This ordinance will sunset on the third anniversary of its passage unless continued by Assembly action.

Section 2: That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval.
