AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE AUTHORIZING A SALE BY 11 ANCHORAGE WATER AND WASTEWATER UTILITY (AWWU) OF TRACT 4. 12 INTERNATIONAL EAST SUBDIVISION, PLAT NO. 87-28, GENERALLY LOCATED EAST OF 13 MINNESOTA BOULEVARD AND SOUTH OF 56TH AVENUE IN THE ANCHORAGE 14 RECORDING DISTRICT AND THE ACQUISITION OF 2.04 +/- ACRES OF LAND GENERALLY 15 LOCATED ON THE WEST SIDE OF ARCTIC BOULEVARD AT WEST 32ND AVENUE IN THE 16 ANCHORAGE RECORDING DISTRICT, OWNED BY THE HORRELL FAMILY PARTNERSHIP. 17

WHEREAS, Tract A, generally located at International Airport Road and Minnesota Boulevard has become surplus to AWWU; and

WHEREAS, the Horrell Family Partnership owns approximately two acres of land immediately adjacent the southern lot line of the AWWU Headquarters, located at 3000 Arctic Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Assembly approved AO No. 99-79 (June 8, 1999) authorizing AWWU to
sell Tract 4, International East Subdivision to Discovery Construction, Inc. for the appraised fair
market value of \$1,931,000.00; an amount equal to the value of the Horrell Family Partnership
property (\$690,000) plus cash in the amount of \$1,241,000.00; and

WHEREAS, a time extension to September 2000 was requested by Discovery Construction in order to
 obtain financing and accommodate the sale to Discovery Construction of Tract 4, International East
 Subdivision,; and

WHEREAS, the Spenard Community Council, Westside Community Patrol, JC Penney and KTVA
Channel 11 have encouraged and endorsed the acquisition, clean-up and fencing of the Horrell property
by AWWU as a means to eliminating the criminal activity in the area; and

WHEREAS, the Horrell Family Partnership property is of the highest and best value to AWWU
because it is the only land available to facilitate future expansion; and

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42 WHEREAS, Discovery Construction, Inc. has assigned its interest in the Horrell Family Partnership
43 property to the MOA-AWWU with a value of \$705,000; and

WHEREAS, the assignment of the Horrell Family Partnership property to MOA-AWWU assures
acquisition of this property by AWWU; and

WHEREAS, the clean-up and fencing of the Horrell property will not occur this year unless AWWU
 acquires the property separately; and

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WHEREAS, it is the intent of AWWU to purchase the Horrell property directly from the Horrell Family Partnership in February 2000 and extend the sale agreement with Discovery Construction, Inc. for Tract 4, International East Subdivision.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. AO No. 99-79 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Discovery Construction, Inc., shall purchase Tract 4, International East Subdivision from AWWU no later than September 30, 2000 for the fair market value of \$1,931,000 in cash.

Section 3. AWWU shall purchase directly from the Horrell Family Partnership a parcel of land described as that portion of the East one-half (E 1/2) of the Northeast one-quarter (NE 1/4) of Section 25, Township 13 North Range 4 West, S.M., Anchorage Recording District, Third Judicial District, Alaska for \$705,000 plus standard customary closing costs.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage.
