AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE TERMINATING THE EXISTING ANCHORAGE POLICE AND FIRE RETIREMENT SYSTERM; TRANSFERRING ASSETS OF THE TERMINATED SYSTEM TO A NEW ANCHORAGE POLICE AND FIRE RETIREMENT SYSTEM; PROVIDING FOR DISTRIBUTION OF CERTAIN SURPLUS ASSETS OF THE TERMINATED SYSTEM; REPEALING CHAPTER 3.85, ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE IN ITS ENTIRETY; ENACTING A NEW CHAPTER 3.85, ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE; PROVIDING FOR A TRANSITION OF AUTHORITY FOR MANAGEMENT OF THE NEW RETIREMENT SYSTEM, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

The Assembly adopts the valuation report of the actuary for the Retirement System as of January 1, 2000 and the Settlement Agreement, both attached hereto and incorporated herein as

Attachments A. and B. respectively, providing for transfer of certain assets to a new Anchorage Police and Fire Retirement System, the payment of enhanced benefits, the payment of certain court approved legal fees, and a distribution of certain surplus monies to the Municipality.

Anchorage Municipal Code Chapter 3.85/is hereby repealed in its entirety. A new Anchorage their Municipal Code Chapter 3.85 attached hereto and incorporated herein as Attachment C. (Exhibit A. to the Settlement Agreement) is hereby adopted.

Section 4:

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in the new Anchorage Municipal Code chapter 3.85, the Board of Trustees of the terminated Retirement System is hereby continued and empowered to administer the new retirement system until a new Board of Trustees can be appointed in accordance with the new Chapter 3.85. The elected trustees of the terminated system shall automatically continue as trustees of the new system until the expiration of their current terms.*

Section 5:

During the transition between the terminated system and the new system, all benefits previously approved shall continue without interruption. The Board of Trustees shall have full authority to pay all authorized benefits, including the distribution of enhanced benefits provided for in the schedule adopted in Section 2 of this ordinance. During this transitional phase, the Board of Trustees may adopt such rules as are necessary to implement the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 6:

Within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this ordinance, the vacant positions on the new Board of Trustees shall be filled. Within thirty (30) days of the date of this ordinance, the prior system shall have been terminated so as to permit assets to be actually and of record transferred to the new system, and a one time distribution of \$40 million to the Municipality to occur. All other facets of the transition between the prior system and the current system shall be accomplished at the earliest practicable date. After the one time distribution to the Municipality, all beneficial, residual, and reversionary interests in the trust assets, including any surpluses, belong to the members, after payment of all benefits required by law.

Section 7:

Should any portion of this ordinance, including the incorporated provisions, be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining portions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect as if the invalid portion had not been adopted.

*The provisions governing membership, composition, and duties of the retirement board, as well as those governing the processing of disability retirement claims which are set forth in Attachment C. shall govern all disability and retirement claims, regardless of the date of injury or illness or when filed.

Section 8:

This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage.
