AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE MUNICIPAL SCHOOL DISTRICT'S DISPOSAL BY DEMOLITION OF THE FORMER MULDOON ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND THE FORMER RUSSIAN JACK ELEMENTARY SCHOOL BUILDINGS.

WHEREAS, a fire destroyed a significant portion of Russian Jack Elementary School on December 27, 1998; and

WHEREAS, the fire resulted in significant damage to the structure including severe damage to 65% of the building's roof area, the majority of the mechanical system, and the electrical system throughout the building; and

WHEREAS, the heat of the fire was so intense as to distort significant structural elements of the building; and

WHEREAS, the building contains PCB's as well as asbestos in the roofing materials, joint compound, pipe fitting insulation, sheet vinyl, carpet mastic, cove base mastic, ceiling tiles, and duct work; and

WHEREAS, if renovated, the building would be required to meet current building codes, including the installation of sprinklers, regardless of the new use; and

WHEREAS, the Anchorage School District has established a standard of 15 acres for elementary schools and related playfields and parking; and

WHEREAS, a new Russian Jack Elementary School has been built on the site of the burned school, located only 60 feet from the old building; and

WHEREAS, the Planning & Zoning Commission approved a site plan for the new school which included a soccer field to be located where the old building currently sits; and

WHEREAS, the Planning & Zoning Commission found that the site plan, as approved, provides Russian Jack Elementary students and the surrounding community with the same opportunities and amenities as students housed in other new prototypical schools such as Trailside (which is located adjacent to Service High School), Kincaid, William Tyson, and others; and

WHEREAS, it will cost in excess of \$6 million to renovate the old building and bring it into code compliance; and

WHEREAS, neither the Anchorage School District nor the Municipality has funds available for the renovation of this building, suggesting that the building may be required to sit in its current condition for several years prior to being renovated; and

WHEREAS, Municipal code requires abandoned buildings to be renovated or demolished within twelve months after the building becomes abandoned; and WHEREAS, the greater good to the Russian Jack community is removal of this dangerous building to be replaced with a soccer field for use by students and neighborhood residents; and WHEREAS, Muldoon Elementary School was constructed on a nine acre site from several temporary ATCO trailers: and WHEREAS, the building was in a deteriorating condition when voters approved a bond proposition to replace the existing Muldoon Elementary School; and WHEREAS, with the exception of four new kindergarten classrooms, the new Muldoon Elementary School is nearly complete and students have moved in; and WHEREAS, in order to complete construction of the four classrooms it is necessary to demolish the old school: and WHEREAS, without this demolition, there will not be adequate space on the site for outdoor playfields; and WHEREAS, the old Muldoon Elementary School is of little value to the community; and WHEREAS, a school site complete with adequate outdoor facilities has great value to the community; NOW THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly ordains: THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS Section 1. In accordance with Anchorage Municipal Code section 25.30.020, the Assembly hereby authorizes the Municipality's school district to dispose of the former Muldoon Elementary and Russian Jack Elementary school buildings by demolition. Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the PASSED AND APPROVED by the Anchorage Assembly this 18th day of Cyril, 2000.
