AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING
ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 4.60.100, REGARDING MEMBERSHIP
OF THE PUBLIC TRANSIT ADVISORY BOARD.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1: That AMC Section 4.60.100 is amended to read as follows:


4.60.100 Public transit advisory board.

There is established a public transit advisory board consisting of ~~eleven~~ nine
[NINE] persons to advise the assembly and the mayor. At least two of the members
shall be representatives from the disabled community. The board is intended to
contribute to the long-range planning of a balanced public transit system in the
municipality. The board is not intended to regulate the transportation industry or to
adjudicate the rights and duties of public and private carriers. The board shall:
