1 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPALITY TO GRANT A
2 TELECOMMUNICATIONS EASEMENT ACROSS A PORTION OF TURNAGAIN
3 ELEMENTARY SCHOOL SITE LOCATED NEAR WEST NORTHERN LIGHTS
4 BOULEVARD AND MCKENZIE DRIVE, TAX #010-042-26

7 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS

9 SECTION 1. That the telecommunications easement area requested by
10 Alaska Communications Systems (ACS) is described as:

12 The East 20 feet of the West 35 feet of the South 20 feet of the North 30 feet of
13 Turnagain Elementary School Subdivision, according to Plat 71-145 on file in the
14 Office of the District Recorder, Anchorage Recording District, Seward Meridian,
15 Alaska, containing approximately 400 square feet.

17 SECTION 2. That the Anchorage School District has no objection to
18 granting a telecommunications easement within the Turnagain School Site located near
19 West Northern Lights Boulevard and McKenzie Drive.

21 SECTION 3. That ACS has offered fair market value of \$800 for the
22 telecommunications easement.

23
24 SECTION 4. That the Administration shall grant the telecommunications
25 easement to ACS.

27 SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon
28 passage and approval.
