AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 23, SECTION 23.85.316 OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE AND PROVIDING FOR A CHANGE IN THE SMOKE DETECTOR REQUIREMENTS FOR ALTERATIONS, REPAIRS AND ADDITIONS IN RESIDENTIAL DWELLINGS.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Anchorage Municipal Code Section 23.85.316 is hereby amended to read as follows:

23.85.316 Smoke Detectors

316.1.1 Alterations, repairs and additions. When alterations, repairs or additions in the interior, habitable space requiring a permit occur, or when one or more sleeping rooms are added or created in existing dwellings, the entire building shall be provided with smoke detectors located as required for new dwellings; the smoke detectors are not required to be interconnected unless other remodeling considerations require removal of the appropriate wall and ceiling coverings to facilitate concealed interconnected wiring.

316.1.2 Power source. Required smoke detectors shall receive their primary power from the building wiring when such wiring is served from a commercial source, and when primary power is interrupted, shall receive power from a battery. Wiring shall be permanent and without a disconnecting switch other than those required for overcurrent protection. Smoke detectors may be battery operated when installed in buildings without commercial power.

Exception: In case of alterations, repairs and additions, minimum 10-year battery-powered single station smoke detectors which are listed and approved shall be permitted outside the work area.

(The remainder of this section is not affected by this ordinance and is therefore not set out.)

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Assembly.
