**AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY DESIGNATING
THAT A REGULAR MEETING OF THE ASSEMBLY SHALL BE HELD ON WEDNESDAY,
NOVEMBER 8, 2000.**

WHEREAS, according to the Assembly-approved schedule of Assembly meetings, a regular Assembly meeting is scheduled to be held on Tuesday, November 7, 2000; and

WHEREAS, Tuesday, November 7, 2000, is also 'election day' for Federal and State elections; and

WHEREAS, AMC 2.30.030 A. allows for changes to the designated Assembly regular meeting day of each Tuesday by inclusion of the phrase "unless otherwise designated by the Assembly"; and

WHEREAS, to change the Tuesday, November 7, 2000 regular meeting to Wednesday, November 8, 2000, the Assembly must approve the change by ordinance, as instructed by the Municipal Attorney's Office.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1: That the Assembly's regular meeting of Tuesday, November 7, 2000 is canceled and the Assembly designates that a regular meeting of the Assembly shall be held on Wednesday, November 8, 2000 at 5:00 p.m. in the Assembly Chambers.

Section 2: That this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passage and approval.
