AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTIONS 28.20.010 AND 28.20.040 TO CLARIFY THE NOTICE PROVISIONS FOR SPECIAL ELECTION OF CANDIDATES TO MUNICIPAL OFFICES.

Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code sections 28.20.010 and 28.20.040 are hereby amended as follows: (the remainder of the sections are not affected and therefore not set out)

28.20.010 Time for elections.

B. The assembly may call a special election upon at least 30 days' notice, unless the election is for the purpose of electing candidates to fill offices, in which case the assembly shall call the election upon [GIVE] at least 45 days' notice.

28.20.040 Notice of election.

- A. The municipal clerk shall give at least two notices of each election. The first notice shall be given:
 - 2. At least 20 [30] days before a special election in which there are candidates.
