A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY APPROVING A CONDITIONAL USE FOR SALES OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES (PACKAGE STORE) LOCATED ON HUFFMAN BUSINESS PARK SUBDIVISION, TRACT N-1, GENERALLY LOCATED ON THE NORTH SIDE OF EAST HUFFMAN ROAD AND WEST OF NEW SEWARD HIGHWAY.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

- Section 1. The conditional use permit for package store located on Huffman
- 14 Business Park Subdivision, Tract N-1, is approved subject to the following
- 15 conditions:
- 1. A notice of Zoning Action shall be filed with the District Recorders Office within 120 days of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board's approval of the license.
- All construction and uses shall conform to the plans and narrative submitted.
- Current information on tenants and a site layout of all required parking shall be provided to Land Use Enforcement to determine adequacy of parking.
- Verify with Land Use Enforcement that visual enhancement landscaping per AMC 21.40.200M, AMC 21.45.080W, and Plat 89-73 has been provided.
- The use of the property by any person for the permitted purposes shall comply with all current and future federal, state and local laws and regulations including but not limited to laws and regulations pertaining to the sale, dispensing, service and consumption of alcoholic beverages and the storage, preparation, sale, service and consumption of food. The owner of the property, the licensee under the Alcoholic Beverage Control license and their officers, agents and employees shall not knowingly

2	permit or negligently fail to prevent the occurrence of illegal activity on the property.
3	Section 2. Failure to comply with the conditions of this conditional use permit
4	shall constitute grounds for its revocation.
5	Section 3. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage and
6	approval by the Anchorage Assembly.
