A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF FIRE FIGHTERS – LOCAL 1264 AND THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE TO INCORPORATE AN ALTERNATE WORK SCHEDULE FOR FIRE DISPATCH

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage (hereinafter MOA) and the International Association of Fire Fighters, Local 1264 (hereinafter IAFF) recognize that collective bargaining is the preferred method to settle labor disputes; and

WHEREAS, the MOA and the IAFF agree that there exists a need to insure adequate coverage in Fire Dispatch with limited resources in number of employees; and

WHEREAS, the MOA and the IAFF have negotiated an alternate work schedule for Fire Dispatch which provides extended work hours on a daily basis with a minimal increase in mandatory overtime while meeting the coverage needs during critical times of the day, and

WHEREAS, Anchorage Municipal Code 3.70.130, B., requires that, "All administrative letters interpreting provisions of a labor agreement shall be submitted to the assembly for review and approval."

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly hereby approves of the letter of agreement that amends Articles 10.2, 10.5, and 14.4 of the collective bargaining agreement to incorporate an alternate work schedule for Fire Dispatch.
