A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY OPPOSING SENATE BILL 203, "AN ACT RELATING TO METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATIONS AND TO DESIGNATION 10 OF A METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION FOR THE ANCHORAGE METROPOLITAN AREA; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

WHEREAS, the current Metropolitan Planning Organization consists of two 15 Assemblymembers, the Mayor, and two representatives from the State of Alaska (Department of Transportation and Department of Environmental Conservation); and

WHEREAS, the Municipality and the State currently have a balanced and cooperative working relationship in the development of transportation and air quality plans; and

WHEREAS, 23 United States Code 134 states that a metropolitan planning organization is designated "by agreement among the Governor and the units of general purpose local government;" and

WHEREAS, the Municipality and the Governor must agree to any changes in the existing Metropolitan Planning Organization's membership; and 26

WHEREAS, the action to change the AMATS process, entered into unilaterally by the State of Alaska could endanger federal highway funding for Anchorage, which is intended to be handled cooperatively between the Municipality and the State; and

WHEREAS, the Assembly does not support inclusion of a voting or nonvoting member from 33 the Senate and the House.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

Section 1: That the Assembly opposes Senate Bill 203 which modifies the membership of the 38 Metropolitan Planning Organization.

Section 2: That the Municipal Clerk forward copies of this resolution to the Governor and the State Legislature upon passage and approval.

- Sec. 19.20.200. Designation of metropolitan planning organizations. In order to coordinate transportation planning in urbanized areas and achieve the
- 9 transportation planning goals of 23 U.S.C. 134 and 49 U.S.C. 5303 5306, a
- metropolitan planning organization shall be designated for each metropolitan area of
- 11 the state when required for participation in a federal transportation program. A
- metropolitan area is an urbanized area with a population of more than 50,000 persons.
- Each metropolitan planning organization shall be designated by act of the legislature.

* Sec. 2. The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to read:

DESIGNATION OF A METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION FOR THE ANCHORAGE METROPOLITAN AREA. (a) The governor shall establish a metropolitan planning organization for the Anchorage metropolitan area in conformance with AS 19.20.200 and 19.20.210, added by sec. 1 of this Act, and with applicable federal law.

(b) This provision constitutes legislative designation of a metropolitan planning organization for the Anchorage metropolitan area in accordance with AS 19.20.200, added by

- * Sec. 3. Section 1 of this Act takes effect July 1, 2001
