A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY SUPPORTING SB NO. 291
AND HB NO. 434(TRA), "AN ACT NAMING THE TED STEVENS ANCHORAGE
INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

WHEREAS, Anchorage International Airport is the major air gateway to the State of Alaska
and has the distinction of being the key international cargo crossroads for transpacific freighter
activity with growth continuing in international and domestic passenger service, as well as
international cargo; and

WHEREAS, Senator Ted Stevens has served in the United States Senate with distinction
for more than 31 years and, during his tenure, he has made enormous contributions to and
accomplishments within the State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, these achievements include his efforts in creating the Alaska Native Claims
Settlement Act, working for Congressional approval of the Trans-Alaska Pipeline, protecting
Alaska's fisheries, and expanding economic opportunities throughout the State; and

WHEREAS, Senator Stevens has maintained his stance on the importance of our State's
airport transportation industry and he initiated bypass mail and numerous other measures, which
have elevated Alaska's transportation level to the "air crossroads of the World"; and

WHEREAS, because of Senator Stevens' contributions to the State and his successful
efforts in increasing funding for the Anchorage International Airport, it is befitting that the Anchorage
International Airport be renamed the Ted Stevens International Airport.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

Section 1: That this body is honored to support SB 291 and HB 434 which would rename
the Anchorage International Airport to the Ted Stevens International Airport.


Section 2: That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Alaska State Legislature and
