
A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE ACCEPTING THE SUM OF  
FORTY MILLION DOLLARS (\$40,000,000) FROM THE POLICE AND FIRE  
RETIREMENT SYSTEM AS A CONTRIBUTION OF TWENTY MILLION DOLLARS  
(\$20,000,000) TO THE MOA TRUST FUND (730) AND TWENTY MILLION DOLLARS  
(\$20,000,000) TO THE MOA TRUST FUND RESERVE (731)

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

**Section 1:** That the sum of forty million dollars (\$40,000,000) is hereby accepted  
from the Police and Fire Retirement System as a contribution of twenty-million dollars  
(\$20,000,000) to the MOA Trust Fund (730) and a contribution of twenty-million dollars  
(\$20,000,000) to the MOA Trust Fund Reserve (731).

**Section 2:** This resolution shall take effect upon passage and approval by the  
Anchorage Assembly.



SUBJECT: Veto of Assembly Resolution AR 2000-106

Last night, six members of the Assembly voted not to commit any of our \$40 million surplus to immediate tax relief.

This surplus is primarily a result of overpayment by Anchorage taxpayers to the Police and Fire Retirement System.

By this veto, I am sending a clear and direct message to the Assembly that I will not support any use of these funds which does not include using a substantial portion for immediate reduction of property taxes.

When the city has a surplus of this magnitude and the Assembly fails to dedicate any portion of it for immediate property tax relief, it sends a message to Anchorage taxpayers. It tells them that reducing property taxes is not a priority. That message is wrong. Reducing property taxes must be a priority.
