A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY ESTABLISHING A PROCESS FOR THE ASSEMBLY'S APPOINTMENT OF A NEW MEMBER TO TEMPORARILY FILL ASSEMBLY SEAT 4F UPON THE RESIGNATION OF ASSEMBLY MEMBER AND MAYOR-ELECT GEORGE WUERCH UNTIL SAID ASSEMBLY SEAT MAY BE FILLED BY THE VOTERS AT A SPECIAL ELECTION WITHIN SIXTY DAYS AFTER SAID RESIGNATION BECOMES EFFECTIVE

WHEREAS, a vacancy will occur upon the resignation of Assembly Member and Mayor-elect George Wuerch to assume the office of Mayor ("Vacancy"); and

WHEREAS, Anchorage Municipal Charter Section 7.02(b) requires the Vacancy to be filled within sixty days after the date the Vacancy occurs and Charter Section 11.02(b) may require a runoff election to fill the Vacancy; and

WHEREAS, the call and conduct of the elections could take more than 90 days; and

WHEREAS, Anchorage Municipal Charter Section 7.02(b) permits the Assembly to fill the Vacancy by appointment until a special election may be held; and

WHEREAS, during that 90 day period, the Assembly will be asked to make policy decisions that affect citizens individually and collectively; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Anchorage will be better served if someone is appointed to fill Assembly Seat 4F until special and runoff elections can be held and certified; now therefore,

THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1: That Assembly Seat 4F shall be filled by Assembly appointment until a candidate is elected at a special election in accordance with the Charter.

Section 2: That the Municipal Clerk shall cause a notice of vacancy to be published in accordance with Anchorage Municipal Code 2.70.020.

Section 3: That applications for a temporary appointment to Assembly Seat 4F shall be filed with the Municipal Clerk prior to 5:00 p.m. on July 14, 2000, and shall be forwarded to the Assembly. Applications received after this date and time shall not be considered by the Assembly.

Section 4: That applicants will be evaluated solely on the basis of written materials submitted. No interviews will be conducted.

Section 5: That the Assembly will appoint a qualified applicant to fill the vacancy by casting successive secret ballots until one applicant receives a majority vote. Balloting will occur at a regular or special meeting on or before July 25, 2000. The successful applicant will be sworn into office and seated at this meeting.

Section 6: That this resolution shall become effective upon passage and approval.
