WHEREAS, Tony was part of the integration team of Family Planning and the Sexually Transmitted Disease Programs to better accommodate services for clients. These programs are recognized as "tops" in the State of Alaska, United States Public Health Services, Department of Health & Human Services, Region X, and the Centers for Disease Control in Georgia; and

WHEREAS, Tony is respected for his high professional ethics, dedication to his work, and his passion for teaching and public speaking. Tony is often sought out by his peers as an authority and a consultant, and has received several awards and recognition for his work; and 36

WHEREAS, Tony has promoted the STD Program as a training center for numerous professional health care providers. These include Family Practice Physicians, State Public Health Nurses, student nurses, student nurse practitioners, WAMI medical students, physician assistant students, and Village Health Aides.

TONY BELL


and his many contributions to the betterment of Anchorage's public health upon his retirement from public service.
