A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AUTHORIZING THE HERITAGE LAND BANK TO MAKE A PORTION OF THE GIRDWOOD INDUSTRIAL PARK AVAILABLE FOR OVERNIGHT CAMPING IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE 2000 GIRDWOOD FOREST FAIR

WHEREAS, the Girdwood Forest Fair has a long history of providing family entertainment; and

WHEREAS, the number of people attending and expecting a place to camp have been increasing in recent years; and

WHEREAS, there are no public or private accommodations for campers in the Girdwood Valley or vicinity; and

<u>Section 2:</u> That prior to the 2000 Girdwood Forest Fair, the Fair Organizational Committee representative(s) will meet with the Heritage Land Bank to reach an agreement to fulfill the liability, sanitation, and security requirements necessary to effect the requested overnight camping.
