A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING AND HONORING SCOTT GOMEZ -
NATIONAL HOCKEY LEAGUE ALLSTAR, ROOKIE OF THE YEAR, AND STANLEY CUP CHAMPION

WHEREAS, at an early age, Scott Gomez would spend hours playing hockey, shooting a ball indoors with stray shots leaving indentations on the walls, and working on his slap shots, wrist shots and breakaways against the unlikeliest of goaltenders - his Mom, who would strap pillows on her legs and chest; and

WHEREAS, Scott's youth hockey teams included the Boys & Girls Club, Mat-Su Eagles, Anchorage Northstars, and Alaska Allstars - with Scott winning a National Championship as a Midget in 1996; and

WHEREAS, Scott played hockey for the East High Thunderbirds, averaging more than 3 points per game, leading the State in points, being named Player of the Year both his freshman and sophomore years, and having his jersey retired; and

WHEREAS, Scott continued playing hockey with the South Surrey Eagles of the British Columbia Junior A Hockey League, placing second in team points, being named to the All Rookie Team, and making the Allstar Game; and

WHEREAS, Scott was also chosen to play for the USA World Junior Team in the World Junior Hockey Championships; and

WHEREAS, Scott also played for the Tr-City Americans of the Western Hockey League, placing second in team points and twice being named WHL Player of the Month; and

WHEREAS, in 1998, Scott was drafted in the first round by the New Jersey Devils and in his rookie season in the National Hockey League:

- Scott became the first Hispanic to play in the NHL;
- Scott was the only New Jersey Devil to play in every game;
- Scott led all rookies in points and was named to the NHL All Rookie Team;
- Scott was named to the NHL Allstar Team;
- Scott won the Calder Trophy, designating Scott as the NHL Rookie of the Year; and
- Scott won the Stanley Cup Championship.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves:

That the Assembly recognizes and honors

Scott Gomez

NHL Allstar, Rookie of the Year, and Stanley Cup Champion

and appreciates Scott's efforts to "give back" to the community through donations to the Children's Miracle Network and providing a Summer Skills Clinic for local youth hockey players.
