A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY  
APPROPRIATING FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTY FOUR THOUSAND THREE  
HUNDRED NINETEEN DOLLARS (\$584,319) FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF  
JUSTICE, OFFICE OF JUSTICE PROGRAMS, LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT  
BLOCK GRANT AND SIXTY FOUR THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED TWENTY  
FOUR DOLLARS (\$64,924) AS A CONTRIBUTION FROM THE ANCHORAGE  
METROPOLITAN POLICE SERVICE AREA FUND (151), ANCHORAGE POLICE  
DEPARTMENT 2000 OPERATING BUDGET, TO THE FEDERAL CATEGORICAL  
GRANTS FUND (241), ANCHORAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT, FOR THE  
PURPOSE OF UNDERWRITING PROJECTS TO REDUCE CRIME AND IMPROVE  
PUBLIC SAFETY.

THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the sum of FIVE HUNDRED EIGHTY FOUR THOUSAND  
THREE HUNDRED NINETEEN DOLLARS (\$584,319), is appropriated from the U.S.  
Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Local Law Enforcement Block Grant  
(LLEBG) Program to the Federal Categorical Grants Fund (241), Anchorage Police  
Department for underwriting projects to reduce crime and improve public safety.

Section 2. That the sum of SIXTY FOUR THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED  
TWENTY FOUR DOLLARS (\$64,924) as a match from the Anchorage Metropolitan  
Police Service Area Fund (151) to the Federal Categorical Grant Fund (241) for the  
purpose of underwriting projects to reduce crime and improve public safety.

Section 3 This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and  
approval.

Subject: Appropriation from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs for a Local Law Enforcement Block Grant (LLEBG)  
Award – 2000-LB-VX-1072. \$649,243

Local Law Enforcement Block Grants, authorized by the Omnibus Consolidated and Emergency Supplement Appropriations Act, 1999 Public Law 105-277, provide local governments with funds to underwrite projects to reduce crime and improve public safety. The Municipality of Anchorage has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$584,319 with a required match of \$64,924 for a total program budget of \$649,243. These amounts are requested to be appropriated to the Federal Categorical Grant Fund (241) for use by the Anchorage Police Department. The term of this grant is 24 months from the date drawn by the Municipality.

The Grant Advisory Board met on June 15, 2000 and recommended the use of funding as follows:

\$ 63,973	Officer overtime supporting traffic enforcement and juvenile/violent crimes
\$ 20,000	Community Surveys
\$ 50,000	AED's – Defibrulators
\$ 300,000	Sexual Assault Response Team (SART) contract (2-years)
\$ 200,000	Digital Voice Recording & Information Storage System.
\$ 15,270	Inter Governmental Charges
<u>\$ 649,243</u>	

As required, a public hearing notice was advertised in the local newspaper and the hearing was held on June 29, 2000 in the Mayor's Conference Room. The hearing provided the community an opportunity to comment on the proposed use of this block grant. No public comments were expressed at the hearing.




