1 A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ADOPTION OF THE 2000-2004 PUBLIC  
2 TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT PLAN AS A BASIS FOR THE GROWTH AND  
3 DEVELOPMENT OF PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

5 WHEREAS, extensive planning, data collection and community involvement  
6 have established the framework for the Public Transportation Development Plan charting the  
7 course of development of public transportation in the Anchorage metropolitan area, and

8  
9 WHEREAS, the Public Transportation Department provides People Mover bus  
10 service, Share-A-Ride car pool and van pool service, and AnchorRIDES paratransit service  
11 for the citizens and visitors of Anchorage, and

12  
13 WHEREAS, the 2000-2004 Public Transportation Development Plan  
14 recommends greater efficiency of existing public transportation resources, and

15  
16 WHEREAS, the 2000-2004 Public Transportation Development Plan  
17 recommends a focused effort on improving the image of the public transportation system, and

18  
19 WHEREAS, the 2000-2004 Public Transportation Development Plan  
20 recommends a prioritized listing of service expansion based on thirteen criteria.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

23  
24 Section 1. The Assembly adopts the Public Transportation Development  
25 Plan as the general basis for development of public transportation within the Municipality of  
26 Anchorage. The plan is intended to provide the following functions:

28 to establish public transportation priorities and timeframes to execute planned  
29 transportation enhancements, based on availability of funding;

30  
31 to establish public policy and unified strategy regarding the Municipal transportation  
32 improvement objectives.
