1 A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING FIVE  
2 HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND (\$525,000) TO THE STATE CATEGORICAL  
3 GRANTS FUND (231) FROM THE FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION THROUGH  
4 THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES AND A  
5 CONTRIBUTION OF FOUR HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE THOUSAND (\$475,000) OF THE  
6 GRANT TO THE AREAWIDE GENERAL FUND (101) TO PROVIDE FOR CONGESTION  
7 MANAGEMENT AND AIR QUALITY MITIGATION THROUGH FREE FIXED ROUTE  
8 BUS SERVICE DURING THE WINTER MONTHS WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY

10 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

11  
12 Section 1. That a sum of Five Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$525,000) is hereby  
13 appropriated to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231), Public Transportation Department, from  
14 the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to provide funding congestion  
15 management and air quality mitigation through free fixed route bus service within the Municipality  
16 of Anchorage. The free bus service will be provided during the months of November and December  
17 in 2000 and January in 2001.

19 Section 3. That Four Hundred Seventy-five Thousand (\$475,000) is appropriated as a  
20 contribution from the State Categorical Grants Fund (231) to the Areawide General Fund (101),  
21 Public Transportation Department to offset passenger revenues as follows: \$318,250 in Budget Year  
22 2000 and \$156,750 in Budget Year 2001.

24 Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval.
