1 A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE ACCEPTING A SECTION 5307 GRANT FROM THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION FOR \$1.608.800 2 3 AND APPROPRIATING ONE MILLION FOUR HUNDRED THIRTY-SIX THOUSAND 4 EIGHT HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$1,436,800) THEREFROM TO THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND (485) AND ONE HUNDRED 5 DOLLARS (\$172,000) SEVENTY-TWO THOUSAND TO THE 6 FEDERAL 7 CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (241) AND A CONTRIBUTION OF FORTY THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$43,000) FROM THE AREAWIDE GENERAL FUND (101) TO 8 THE FEDERAL CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (241) FOR OPERATING AND 9 CAPITAL ASSISTANCE TO THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM IN THE 10 11 MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage periodically applies for and receives Federal Transit Administration (FTA) grants for capital, operation and other purposes in connection with operation of its transit system,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

Section 1 The Administration is authorized to accept a FTA Section 5307 grant.

Section 2. That the sum of One Million Four Hundred Thirty-six Thousand Eight
Hundred Dollars (\$1,436,800) is hereby accepted and appropriated from the Federal
Transit Administration to the Public Transportation Capital Fund (485) to fund the
purchase of Public Transportation Capital Items.

That the sum of Forty-three Thousand Dollars (\$43,000) is hereby appropriated as a contribution from the Areawide General Fund (101) to the Federal Categorical Grants Fund (241) to co-fund a transportation skills assessment center and travel training program for people with disabilities and for senior citizens.

Section 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and
approval by the Municipal Assembly of Anchorage.
