A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ESTABLISHING A PROCESS FOR THE ASSEMBLY'S APPOINTMENT OF A NEW MEMBER TO TEMPORARILY FILL ASSEMBLY SEAT 4G UPON THE RESIGNATION OF ASSEMBLY MEMBER AND STATE REPRESENTATIVE-ELECT KEVIN MEYER UNTIL A SUCCESSOR CAN BE ELECTED BY THE VOTERS AT THE REGULAR ELECTION ON APRIL 3, 2001 TO COMPLETE THE TERM

WHEREAS, a vacancy will occur upon the resignation of Assembly Member and State Representative-Elect Kevin Meyer to assume the office of State Representative ("Vacancy"); and

WHEREAS, Anchorage Municipal Charter Section 7.02(b) provides that if a vacancy occurs less than six months prior to the next Regular Election the vacancy may be filled by appointment; and

WHEREAS, the Vacancy will occur less than three months before the next Regular Election; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of Anchorage will be better served if someone is appointed to fill Assembly Seat 4G until Regular and Run-off elections can be held and certified.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

Section 1: That Assembly Seat 4G shall be filled by Assembly appointment until a candidate is elected at the April 3, 2001 Regular Election in accordance with the Charter.

Section 2: That the Municipal Clerk shall cause a notice of vacancy to be published in accordance with Anchorage Municipal Code 2.70.020.

Section 3: That applications for a temporary appointment to Assembly Seat 4G received by the Municipal Clerk prior to 5:00 p.m. on December 29, 2000 shall be forwarded to the Assembly. Applications received after this date and time shall not be considered by the Assembly.

Section 4: That applicants will be evaluated solely on the basis of written materials submitted. No interviews will be conducted.

Section 5: That the Assembly will appoint a qualified applicant to fill the Vacancy by casting successive ballots until one applicant receives a majority vote. Balloting will occur at the regular meeting on January 9, 2001. The successful applicant will be sworn into office and seated upon final selection.
