A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING AND  
THANKING ALASKA'S LT. GOVERNOR, FRAN ULMER, AND ALASKA DIVISION OF  
ELECTIONS DIRECTOR, JANET KOWALSKI AND ELECTION STAFF AND WORKERS FOR A  
"JOB WELL DONE" IN CONDUCTING THE NOVEMBER 7, 2000 GENERAL ELECTION.

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska's General Election on November 7, 2000 was a challenging  
election to conduct, with a long ballot of seven Presidential and Vice-Presidential candidates, five  
U.S. Representative candidates, 30 judges, and six ballot measures; and

WHEREAS, in addition, the election included 50 of the 60 seats in the State Legislature, with  
10 State Senate seats and 40 State House seats to fill; and

WHEREAS, the election was well-conducted by Alaska Division of Elections staff and more  
than 2,500 election workers throughout the State - with a 60% voter turnout, a precise and timely  
Accu-Vote performance, and a record-breaking number of absentee voters; and

WHEREAS, prior to the election, *Lets Vote! Alaska*, a non-partisan initiative designed to get  
young people between the ages of 18-24 to the polls was directed by Lt. Governor Fran Ulmer; and

WHEREAS, *Kids Voting* was held in Juneau and Fairbanks; and "*Spirit of Youth*" Youth 2000  
Vote was held in Anchorage with 21,385 students in Grades K-12, representing 71 Anchorage  
schools, voting.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves:

That the Assembly recognizes and thanks

***Lt. Governor Fran Ulmer, Alaska Division of Elections Director,  
Janet Kowalski, Election Division Staff and many election workers  
throughout the State for a "job well done"***

in conducting the November 7, 2000 General Election.
