**A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY SUPPORTING THE
CREATION OF THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH - MUNICIPALITY OF
ANCHORAGE INTERGOVERNMENTAL TASK FORCE**

WHEREAS, over sixty percent of the State of Alaska's population resides within the Matanuska-Susitna Borough and Municipality of Anchorage; and

WHEREAS, over sixty percent of the State of Alaska's highway network is located within the Matanuska-Susitna Borough and Municipality of Anchorage; and

WHEREAS, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough and Municipality of Anchorage share one regional economy; and

WHEREAS, it is important for members of the two communities to work together and exchange information on issues of mutual interest such as economic development, education, transportation, and land use planning; and

WHEREAS, establishing a Matanuska-Susitna Borough - Municipality of Anchorage Intergovernmental Task Force with representatives from each governing body and administration would provide a forum for discussing issues of regional interest, identifying opportunities, and developing creative solutions to the challenges faced by the region.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

Section 1: That the Assembly supports the creation of a Matanuska-Susitna Borough - Municipality of Anchorage Intergovernmental Task Force as follows:

A. The Task Force will be composed of:

Municipality of Anchorage

- Two Assembly members appointed by the Assembly Chair;
- The Mayor or designee;
- A representative of the Municipal Administration appointed by the Mayor; and
- An existing member of a Municipal board or commission to be designated by the Mayor and confirmed by the Assembly.

3 Matanuska -Susitna Borough

- 4 • Two Assembly Members appointed by the Assembly Chair;
5 • The Mayor or designee; and
6 • Two members of the Administration appointed by the Mayor.


8 B. The Task Force may create sub-committees composed of Assembly and
9 Administration members to consider specific issues.

11 C. The Task Force may make recommendations to each of the governing
12 bodies and Administrations on areas of mutual interest.

14 D. That the governing bodies of both the Matanuska-Susitna Borough and
15 Municipality of Anchorage and the respective Administrations shall meet at least twice
16 annually to discuss topics of mutual interest.

18 Section 2: That this resolution shall be effective upon passage and approval.
