ANCHORAGE, ALASKA AR NO. 2000- 391

A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY CALLING FOR INCREASED AWARENESS OF ANIMAL CRUELTY, ENCOURAGING CITIZENS TO REPORT INSTANCES OF ANIMAL CRUELTY. AND REQUESTING LAW ENFORCEMENT AND PROSECUTION EFFORTS

WHEREAS, an instance of organized dog fighting and related gambling was recently reported within our community; and

WHEREAS, it is our understanding from the Municipality's Animal Control Center that other animal cruelty cases have occurred in Anchorage this year - with seven animal cruelty cases turned over to the Anchorage Police Department; and

WHEREAS, it is important for citizens to report instances of animal cruelty since this behavior may lead to more serious offenses - the Humane Society of the United States in its First Strike Campaign reports that:

> Violent offenders frequently have childhood and adolescent histories of serious and repeated animal cruelty;

> Since the 1970's, the FBI has recognized animal cruelty as one of a cluster of juvenile behaviors associated with increasingly violent behavior;

> Persons who abuse animals may also harm their parents or spouses, children or elderly members of their households.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

Section 1: That the Assembly calls upon the Municipality's Animal Control Center and other 36 humane agencies to ensure that the issue of animal cruelty is understood by the public.

Section 2: That the Assembly encourages citizens to report instances of animal cruelty.

Section 3: That the Assembly requests that local law enforcement and prosecution agencies take the issue of animal cruelty seriously and prosecute offenders. 41
