A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY REQUESTING THAT
THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES
DEVELOP A SERIES OF LAND USE ALTERNATIVES AND A SERIES OF
TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES AND INTERACTIVELY STUDY ITS
RELATIONSHIP AND EFFECTS IN ORDER TO ACHIEVE THE GOALS OF THE EAST
ANCHORAGE TRANSPORTATION STUDY

WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities will
conduct the East Anchorage Transportation Study; and

WHEREAS, the Study will examine land use and transportation alternatives to
improve mobility, access, livability, and sustainability in Anchorage; and

WHEREAS, the Study will be conducted with meaningful participation by adjacent
neighborhoods and affected citizens, and will examine a series of land use and
transportation alternatives to achieve the Study's goals; and

WHEREAS, the approved Anchorage 2020, Anchorage Bowl Comprehensive Plan
will guide the Study and described future land uses in very general terms, and depend on
sub area plans to determine twenty year land use projects; and

WHEREAS, the Study will need to develop a series of land use scenarios and
compare them with transportation scenarios in more detail than the Comprehensive Plan
can provide.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

That the Anchorage Assembly requests the Alaska Department of Transportation
and Public Facilities to develop a series of land use alternatives and a series of
transportation alternatives and interactively study its relationship and effects in order to
achieve the goals of the East Anchorage Transportation Study.
