A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE REVISING THE 2000 GENERAL GOVERNMENT OPERATING BUDGET TO PROVIDE FOR AN INCREASE OF SALARIES AND BENEFITS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF FIRE FIREFIGHTERS (IAFF), LOCAL NO. 1264 CONTRACT AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the International Association of Fire Firefighters (IAFF), Local No. 1264 contract was approved on June 27, 2000; and

WHEREAS, the approved contract calls for a three percent (3%) across-the-board pay increase effective January 1, 1999. In addition, the agreement provides incentives for paramedic leadership, and rank pay structure changes. This agreement also provides paramedics who have been performing Fire Training Officer (FTO) function to receive a check in the amount of five percent (5%) of their base pay for periods during which they were engaged in training. This eligibility for payment is retroactive to September 1, 1998.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

Section 1. The following change to the Anchorage Fire Department appropriation is approved.


