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PROFESSIONAL SERVICES SELECTION FOR THE SERVICE HIGH SUBJECT:

SCHOOL RENEWAL PROJECT – DESIGN SERVICES

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Service High School was completed in 1971 as a Junior/Senior High School. A pool building, an auxiliary gymnasium, and additional classrooms were all added in 1983. Service High School is located on 58 acres of land on the lower Hillside of South Anchorage. It is bounded on the north by Far North Bicentennial Park, on the east by Hillside Park, on the west by the new Trailside Elementary School, and on the south by Abbott Road. With the completion of Hanshew Junior High School in 1983, Service began operating as a High School for 2,000 students. The Service High School student capacity after all phases of construction are completed will remain at 2,000 students. The estimated project cost for the entire project is \$47,495,000.

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On April 4, 2000, Anchorage voters approved project funding in the \$7,140,000 for the design and construction of the Conceptual Master Plan's Phase I for the Service High School Renewal Project.

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The recommended design firm for Phase I of the project is Architects Alaska. Inc. Architects Alaska, Inc. has been providing services in Alaska since 1950. They have extensive experience in school design and construction administration and have just recently completed work on Anchorage School District projects at Orion, John F. Kennedy, and Ocean View Elementary Schools. Current work for other school districts includes design work at Houston High School and construction administration at Teeland Middle School.

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A Request for Proposal was issued on June 14, 2000. Three firms submitted proposals on July 7, 2000. The proposals were evaluated by the evaluation committee utilizing the evaluation criteria identified in the Request for Proposal. These criteria consisted of project approach, methods, management, firm's experience, proposed project staff, workload and resources, and educational specifications integration. At the completion of this evaluation oral interviews were held with the two top ranked proposers.

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The estimated range of total design fees for this project is \$575,000 - \$625,000, or 11 ½ -12 ½ % of the estimated construction cost of the project.
