AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 21.90.020 TO EXPAND
THE AREA WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY SUBJECT TO UTILITY UNDERGROUNDING
REQUIREMENTS.

Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code subsection 21.90.020B. is hereby amended to read as follows:
(the remainder of the section is not affected and therefore not set out)

21.90.020 **Underground placement required for new or relocated lines;**
exceptions.

B. Except where an assessment district has been formed to convert overhead utility
distribution lines as provided in chapter 19.60:

1. Utility distribution lines need not be placed underground in the rural area
defined in section 21.85.020, or in the I-2 and I-3 zoning districts.
2. CATV utility distribution lines need not be placed underground where there
are other overhead utility distribution lines; provided that, when all of the other
overhead distribution lines are placed underground, the CATV utility
distribution line shall be placed underground in a joint trench with the other
utility distribution lines.
3. Notwithstanding subsection B.1 of this section, the following area shall be
subject to the provisions of subsection A of this section requiring that newly
installed or relocated utility distribution lines shall be placed underground: All
of that area within the Municipality as depicted in Exhibit A, but excluding
Chugach State Park and Chugach National Forest, and generally described as
the area between
 - a) the northern edge of the Abbott Road right-of-way, then east along the
section line common to sections 12 and 13 of T12N, R3W to the
western Chugach State Park boundary; and
 - b) north and east of the Municipality's border with the Kenai Peninsula
Borough; and
 - c) east of the western edge of the New Seward Highway right-of-way
between Abbott Road and Potter Valley Road, from whence the border
shall be the mean high tide line of Turnagain Arm.

[LOWER HILLSIDE, BETWEEN AND INCLUDING ABBOTT ROAD,
RABBIT CREEK ROAD, HILLSIDE DRIVE AND THE NEW SEWARD
HIGHWAY.]

Section 2. This ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by
the Assembly.

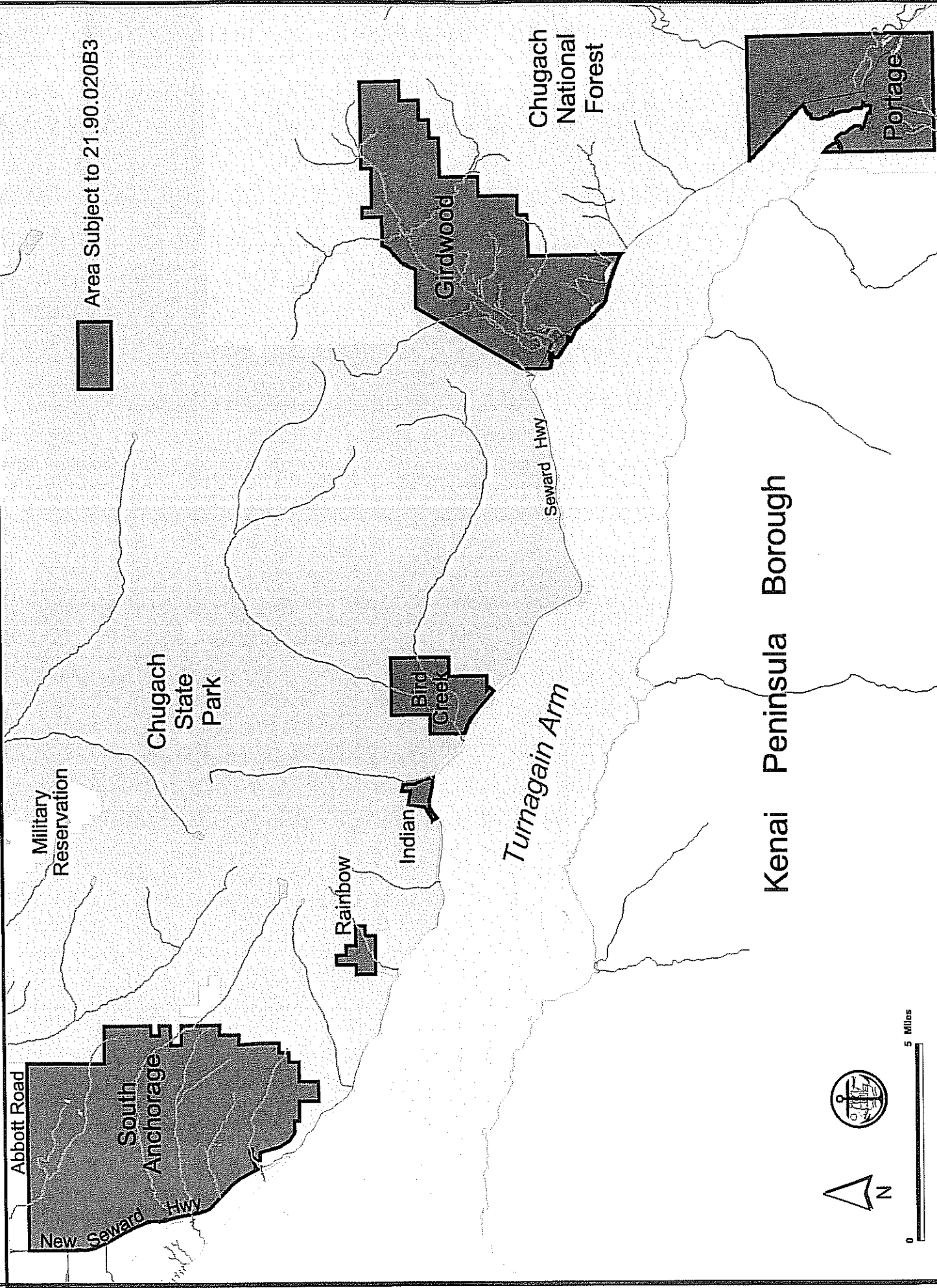

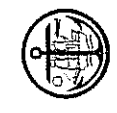
