ORDINANCE NO. AO 2001- 18

AN ORDINANCE SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS RESIDING IN THE TOTEM LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA AT THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION APRIL 3, 2001 A BALLOT PROPOSITION APPROVING THE CONTINUATION OF SAID LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA FOR AN ADDITIONAL PERIOD OF THREE YEARS AND AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTIONS 27.20.340 AND 27.30.610.

WHEREAS THE Totem Limited Road Service Area was created by Anchorage Ordinance 93-45;  
and

WHEREAS a showing of interest in continuing said limited road service beyond December 31, 2001 has been made by persons residing in said limited road service area; now therefore,

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That a ballot proposition in substantially the following form shall be submitted to the qualified voters residing in the Totem Limited Road Service Area at the regular Municipal election on April 3, 2001:

Section 2. That Section 27.20.340 of the Anchorage Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Pursuant to Section 27.10.050, there is established a board of supervisors to administer the Totem Limited Road Service Area (TLRSA). The board shall consist of three members appointed by the mayor and confirmed by the Assembly to administer the service area until the regular election of April 1994, at which time the supervisors will be elected for staggered terms. Initial terms of supervisors elected at the regular election of April 1994 shall be elected by lot. [THE SERVICE AREA WILL EXPIRE ON DECEMBER 31, 2001, UNLESS IT IS EXTENDED BY VOTE IN THE AREA AFFECTED AT THE REGULAR ELECTION OF APRIL 2001.]

Section 3. That Section 27.30.610 of the Anchorage Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

There is a limited road service area within the municipality known as the Totem Limited Road Service Area (TLRSA), to provide limited road maintenance services to the area described on the map located in section 27.30.700.

The Totem Limited Road Service Area shall contribute funds expressly for the maintenance of roads commencing July 1, 1993 and shall end on December 31, [2001] 2004, unless the service area is extended by an affirmative vote of the service area [AFFECTED] at the regular election of April [2001] 2004. The mill rate shall not exceed 1.50 mills in any calendar year.


Section 4. Except for Section 3, this ordinance shall become effective upon passage and approval. Section 3 and the proposition contained in Section 1 shall become effective upon certification of the regular election on the proposition called for by this ordinance, but only if that proposition is approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting on the proposition.

18   Areas expire on December 31, 2001 unless continued by an affirmative vote in  
19   the area affected. Therefore, ten ordinances have been presented requesting  
20   the Assembly propose ballot questions to extend the life of these LRSA's.
