Section 2. That Section 27.20.260 of the Anchorage Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Pursuant to section 27.10.050, there is established a board of supervisors to administer the Upper Grover Limited Road Service Area. The board shall consist of three members appointed by the mayor and confirmed by the Assembly to administer the service area until the regular election of October 1984, at which time the supervisors will be elected for staggered terms. Initial terms of supervisors elected at the regular election of October 1984 shall be selected by lot. [THE SERVICE AREA WILL EXPIRE ON DECEMBER 31, 2001, UNLESS IT IS EXTENDED BY VOTE IN THE AREA AFFECTED AT THE REGULAR ELECTION OF APRIL 2001.]

Section 3. That Section 27.30.340 of the Anchorage Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

There is a limited road service area within the municipality known as the Upper Grover Limited Road Service Area to provide limited road maintenance and repair to the area described on the map located in section 27.30.700.

Limited road maintenance and repair within the service area shall commence on January 1, 1984, and shall end on December 31, [2001] 2004, unless the service area is extended by an affirmative vote of the **service** area [AFFECTED] at the regular election of April [2001] 2004. The mill rate shall not exceed 1.0 mill in any calendar year.

Section 4. Except for Section 3, this ordinance shall become effective upon passage and approval. Section 3 and the proposition contained in Section 1 shall become effective upon certification of the regular election on the proposition called for by this ordinance, but only if that proposition is approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting on the proposition.
