AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF ANCHORAGE, ALASKA, THE QUESTION OF THE ISSUANCE OF THE NINE MILLION DOLLARS (\$9,000,000) OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE TO PAY THE COSTS OF DESIGN, CONSTRUCTION, AND RIGHT-OF-WAY ACQUISITION FOR THE GAMBELL ST./INGRA ST. EXTENSION - SHIP CREEK AVENUE TO THIRD AVENUE.

## THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY HEREBY ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1</u>. It is hereby determined to be for a public purpose and in the public interest of the Municipality of Anchorage, Alaska (the "Municipality") to incur general obligation bonded indebtedness in an amount not to exceed Nine Million Dollars (\$9,000,000) for the purpose of paying the costs of design, construction, and right-of-way acquisition for the Gambell St./Ingra St. Extension - Ship Creek Avenue to Third Avenue located within the Anchorage Roads and Drainage Service Area

Section 2. The sum of not to exceed Nine Million Dollars (\$9,000,000) shall be borrowed by, for and on behalf of the Municipality for the aforesaid design, construction, right-of-way acquisition, and related capital improvements and shall be evidenced by the issuance of general obligation bonds of the Municipality. The bond proceeds shall be used only to pay for capital improvements and costs of issuance of the bonds. The full faith and credit of the Municipality is pledged for the payment of the principal of and interest on the bonds, and ad valorem taxes upon all taxable property within the Municipality shall be levied without limitation as to rate or amount to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds when due The principal of and interest on the bonds are to be paid first from

Section 3. An election is to be held on April 3, 2001, in and for the Municipality, for
the purpose of submitting a general obligation bond proposition to the qualified voters of
the Municipality for approval or rejection The proposition must receive a majority vote of
those in the Municipality voting on the question, both in the Anchorage Roads and
Drainage Service Area and areawide, to be approved. The proposition shall be
substantially in the following form:

## GAMBELL ST./INGRA ST. EXTENSION SHIP CREEK AVENUE TO THIRD AVENUE

- Shall Anchorage borrow up to \$9,000,000 through the issuance of general obligation bonds to pay the costs of design, construction, right-of-way acquisition, and related capital improvements for the Gambell St./Ingra St. Extension Ship Creek Avenue to Third Avenue located within the Anchorage Roads and Drainage Service Area?
- Voter approval of this bond proposition authorizes for each \$100,000 of assessed taxable property value (based on the estimated 2001 assessed valuation in the Anchorage Roads and Drainage Service Area) an annual increase in taxes of approximately \$6.26 necessary to retire the proposed debt.
- 18The debt shall be paid first from real and personal property<br/>taxes levied and collected within the Anchorage Roads and<br/>Drainage Service Area. Anchorage will also pledge its full<br/>faith and credit for payment of the debt.

#### SUMMARY OF ECONOMIC EFFECTS

Private Sector Economic Effects:

The estimated annual debt service payment of approximately \$768,811 equates to a property tax increase of .0626 mills or \$6.26 per year on a \$100,000 of the assessed valuation within the Anchorage Roads and Drainage Service Area.

The increase in debt service would result in an increase in the Municipal tax limitation.
