**AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY PROVIDING FOR THE
SUBMISSION TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF ANCHORAGE, ALASKA AT THE APRIL 3, 2001
REGULAR ELECTION, THE QUESTION OF WHETHER A GENERAL SALES TAX SHALL BE
LEVIED WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE**

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1: That a proposition in substantially the following form be submitted before the qualified voters of Anchorage, Alaska at the April 3, 2001 Regular Election:

PROPOSITION NO. _____

**LEVYING A 2 %
GENERAL SALES TAX
WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE**

Shall the Municipality of Anchorage be authorized to levy a two percent
(2 %) areawide general sales tax **on the price of all retail sales and
rentals of goods and services**, subject to exemptions for food, medical
services and supplies, rental of primary residence, fuels and electricity for
residential heat, light, telephone service, and other exemptions the Assembly
may prescribe, not to exceed \$100 for any single item purchased or rented?

**The revenues collected from the general sales tax authorized by this
proposition shall be substituted for property taxes.**



Section 2: That upon approval of the ballot proposition by 60% of the qualified voters within the Municipality of Anchorage voting on this proposition at the April 3, 2001 Regular Election, the appropriate ordinance changes shall be prepared and implemented effective January 1, 2002.

Section 3: That this ordinance is effective immediately upon passage and approval.
