AN ORDINANCE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE PROVIDING FOR  
SUBMISSION OF A BALLOT PROPOSITION TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS AT THE  
REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION ON APRIL 3, 2001, PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT  
TO THE HOME RULE CHARTER SECTION 13.05, ASSEMBLY ACTION ON THE  
MUNICIPAL BUDGET, CLARIFYING EXERCISE OF THE VETO POWER WITH  
RESPECT TO THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS

**Section 1:** That a proposition in substantially the same form as appears in  
Section 2. below, shall be placed on the ballot at the next regular election. The vote on the  
proposition shall be limited to the qualified voters residing within the Municipality of  
Anchorage. An affirmative vote by a majority (50%) of those voting on the proposition shall  
be required for approval.

**Section 2:** That the proposition shall be presented in substantially the following  
form

AMENDING AND CLARIFYING CHARTER SECTION 13.05,  
ASSEMBLY ACTION ON THE MUNICIPAL BUDGET

Shall the Anchorage Home Rule Charter Section 13.05 be  
amended to read as follows?

Section 13.05. Assembly action on the municipal budget.

The Assembly may increase or decrease any item, and may  
add or delete items, in the proposed operating or capital budget of  
the Municipality. The Assembly shall approve the budget of the  
Municipality as amended and appropriate the necessary funds at  
least 21 days prior to the end of the fiscal year of the Municipality. If  
the Assembly fails to approve [THE] a budget and make the  
necessary appropriation within the time stated, the unamended  
budget [PROPOSAL] first proposed by the mayor shall become the

1 budget and appropriation for the new fiscal year without further  
2 Assembly action. If the mayor vetoes the entire operating or capital  
3 budget approved by the Assembly and that veto is not timely  
4 overridden, the existing level of appropriations and expenditures  
5 shall automatically become the budget for the new fiscal year.
