1 AN ORDINANCE SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE MUNICIPALITY AT THE  
2 REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION APRIL 3, 2001, A BALLOT PROPOSITION TO AMEND  
3 ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CHARTER §13.05 TO MAKE EXPLICIT THAT THE MAYOR'S  
4 PROPOSED BUDGET BECOMES THE BUDGET OF THE MUNICIPALITY IF THE ASSEMBLY  
5 FAILS TO OVERRIDE THE MAYOR'S VETO OF A BUDGET ORDINANCE AND APPROVE A  
6 BUDGET.

9 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS

10  
11 Section 1: That a ballot proposition in substantially the following form shall be submitted to the  
12 qualified voters of the Municipality at the regular Anchorage municipal election April 3, 2001:

16 AMENDING CHARTER §13.05 TO MAKE EXPLICIT  
17 THE EFFECT OF THE ASSEMBLY'S FAILURE TO OVERRIDE  
18 A MAYOR'S VETO OF A BUDGET ORDINANCE

20 Shall Anchorage Municipal Charter §13.05 be amended to read as follows  
21 (Underlined words are proposed new words.)

22  
23 Section 13.05. Assembly action on the municipal budget.

24  
25 The assembly may increase or decrease any item, and may add or delete  
26 items, in the proposed operating or capital budget of the municipality. The  
27 assembly shall approve the budget of the municipality as amended and  
28 appropriate the necessary funds at least 21 days prior to the end of the fiscal  
29 year of the municipality. If the assembly fails to approve the budget and make  
30 the necessary appropriation within the time stated, either before or by veto  
31 override after a veto of all or a portion of a budget, the mayor's last budget  
32 proposal shall become the budget and appropriation for the fiscal year  
33 without further assembly action.

37 Section 2: The proposition contained in Section 1. of this ordinance shall become effective upon  
38 certification of the April 3, 2001 election if, and only if, it is approved by a majority of the qualified

3  
4 voters voting on the Proposition at said election. All other Sections of this ordinance shall become effective  
5 immediately upon passage and approval by the Assembly.
