AN ORDINANCE SUBMITTING AT THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION APRIL 03, 2001 TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE ANCHORAGE ROADS AND DRAINAGE SERVICE AREA ("ARDSA") AND THE AREA TO BE ANNEXED A BALLOT PROPOSITION TO EXTEND THE EASTERN BOUNDARY OF ARDSA BETWEEN HUFFMAN AND DEARMOUN ROADS TO A LINE FIFTY FEET (50') EAST OF THE WEST SECTION LINE OF SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 12 NORTH, RANGE 3 WEST, SEWARD MERIDIAN. (A LINE APPROXIMATELY PARALLEL TO AND 50 FEET EAST OF THE CURRENT CENTERLINE OF ELMORE ROAD.)

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1: That a ballot proposition in substantially the following form shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the Anchorage Roads and Drainage Service Area and the area to be added thereto by the proposition at the regular Anchorage municipal election April 03, 2001:

Proposition

AMENDING THE EASTERN BOUNDARY OF THE ANCHORAGE ROADS AND DRAINAGE SERVICE AREA BETWEEN HUFFMAN AND DEARMOUN ROADS BY MOVING SAID BOUNDARY TO A LINE APPROXIMATELY PARALLEL TO AND FIFTY FEET THE EAST OF THE CURRENT CENTERLINE OF ELMORE ROAD TO ACCOMMODATE THE IMPROVEMENT OF ELMORE ROAD.

Shall the eastern boundary of the Anchorage Roads and Drainage Service Area between Huffman and DeArmoun Roads be extended east to a line fifty feet (50') east of the west section line of Section 27, Township 12 North, Range 3 West, Seward Meridian. (A line approximately parallel to and 50 feet east of the current centerline of Elmore road.)

The purpose of this expansion is to provide an adequate right-of-way for the improvement of Elmore Road to serve the needs of the Lower Hillside transportation system and to provide access to the new South Anchorage High School. Elmore Road as it currently exists is within and also is the eastern boundary of ARDSA.
