AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY CONTINUING OR 1 REESTABLISHING THE ANIMAL CONTROL ADVISORY BOARD PURSUANT TO 2 ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 4.05.150. 3

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Pursuant to Anchorage Municipal Code Section 4.05.150, the Animal Control Advisory 8 Board shall be and is hereby continued and reestablished as set forth in Anchorage Municipal Code 9 Section 4.60.180 for an additional period of three (3) years from and after March 31, 2001. During 10 the period of time from and after March 31, 2001 until the effective date of this ordinance, all 11 actions of the Animal Control Advisory Board, all appointments thereto and all unexpired terms of 12 its members shall continue to be and constitute the actions of, appointments to and the unexpired 13 terms of its members, as the case may be, as if it had not been terminated by operation of law. 14

Section 2. Nothing in this ordinance shall be taken as or constitute any approval, ratification, 16 implementation of, or ruling or action by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly on any action of the 17 Animal Control Advisory Board. 18

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Assembly.
