2 TO REDUCE THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS ON THE HOUSING AND NEIGHBORHOOD
3 DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION TO ELEVEN MEMBERS (11).

6 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

7 Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code section 4.60.260A. is hereby amended to read as follows

9 4.60.260 Housing and neighborhood development commission.

11 A. There is hereby established a housing and neighborhood development commission
12 consisting of eleven (11) [15] members. This commission shall include a minimum
13 of four citizens representing lower-income neighborhoods. The remainder of the
14 commission shall be composed of citizens who experience disabilities, and
15 representatives of each of the following interests: the real estate industry, the banking
16 industry, not-for-profit housing organizations, homebuilders, and residential shelter
17 providers. The director of the department of community planning and development
18 or a designee selected by the mayor, shall act as executive secretary for the
19 commission.
