AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SUBSECTION 4.60,260A.
TO REDUCE THE NUMBER OF MEMBERS ON THE HOUSING AND NEIGHBORHOOD
DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION TO ELEVEN MEMBERS (11).

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code section 4.60.260A. is hereby amended to read as follows

4.60.260 Housing and neighborhood development commission.

There is hereby established a housing and neighborhood development commission Α. consisting of eleven (11) [15] members. This commission shall include a minimum of four citizens representing lower-income neighborhoods. The remainder of the commission shall be composed of citizens who experience disabilities, and representatives of each of the following interests: the real estate industry, the banking industry, not-for-profit housing organizations, homebuilders, and residential shelter providers. The director of the department of community planning and development or a designee selected by the mayor, shall act as executive secretary for the commission.

(The remainder of this section is not affected by this amendment and is therefore not set out.)
