AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 17 AND
TITLE 21 TO PROHIBIT CERTAIN USES INVOLVING DOGS IN THE R-1 AND
R-1A ZONING DISTRICTS.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code subsection 17.10.080A. is hereby
amended to read as follows:

17.10.080 Temporary quartering of dogs in competition.

- A. Subject to the conditions set forth in this Code, a person may quarter
not more than 20 dogs in the municipality for not more than two weeks
prior to and during organized competitions. Quartering dogs in areas
zoned R-1 or R-1A is prohibited. Persons who quarter dogs in areas
zoned [R-1,] R-2 or [, AND] R-4 shall obtain written consent of all adult
residents within a 300-foot radius.

Section 2. Anchorage Municipal Code section 21.40.030 is hereby amended
to read as follows

21.40.030 R-1 and R-1A single-family residential districts.

The following statement of intent and use regulations shall apply in the R-1
and R-1A districts:

- C Permitted accessory uses and structures. Permitted accessory uses
and structures are as follows:

- 4 The outdoor harboring or keeping of [DOGS,] animals and fowl in a manner consistent with the requirements of all other titles of this Code. Paddocks, stables or similar structures or enclosures which are utilized for the keeping of animals other than dogs shall be at least 100 feet from any lot line.

- E. Prohibited uses and structures. The following uses and structures and prohibited:

2. As defined in Title 17, any dog fancier's facility, dog musher's facility, or business facility which provides service to dogs.

- 3[2]. Any use which causes or may reasonably be expected to cause excessive noise, vibration, odor, smoke, dust or other particulate matter, toxic or noxious matter, humidity, heat or glare at or beyond any lot line of the lot on which it is located. The term "excessive" is defined for the purpose of this subsection as to a degree exceeding that generated by uses permitted in the district in their customary manner of operation, or to a degree injurious to the public health, safety, welfare or convenience.


