AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RESCINDING AO 2000-161 REPEALING THE TAX EXEMPTION FOR CIGARETTES AND OTHER TOBACCO PRODUCTS ACQUIRED WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY AND TRANSPORTED FOR RESALE OUTSIDE THE MUNICIPALITY

WHEREAS, on November 21, 2000, the Assembly approved AO 2000-161 amending Anchorage Municipal Code Chapter 12.40 by repealing the tax exemption for cigarettes and other tobacco products acquired within the Municipality and transported for resale outside the Municipality; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated revenues from the repeal of this tax exemption may be lower based on the revised tax cap limitation calculation included in AIM 38-2001 which shows a tobacco tax revenue increase of \$550,000, in comparison to the \$3,000,000 estimate provided with AO 2000-161; and

WHEREAS, it has been identified that the repeal of this exemption may present an adverse economic effect on several business throughout the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly ordains:

Section 1: That AO 2000-161 repealing the tax exemption for cigarettes and other tobacco products acquired within the Municipality and transported for resale outside the Municipality is, hereby, rescinded in its entirety.

Section 2: That this ordinance is effective June , 2001
