AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE TITLE 21 TO INCREASE THE ALLOWABLE MAXIMUM SIGN VIEWING AREA FOR CHURCHES AND SCHOOLS FROM 20 SQUARE FEET TO 50 SQUARE FEET FOR SIGNS ABUTTING COLLECTOR STREETS OR GREATER, TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF SIGNS PER CHURCH OR SCHOOL TO ONE SIGN FOR EACH STREET FRONTAGE, AND TO PERMIT SIGNS FOR SCHOOLS TO BE ILLUMINATED OR LIGHTED.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1: That Section 21.45.160 of the Anchorage Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

21.45.160 Signs.

(Subsections A. - E. of this subsection are not affected by this ordinance and therefore are not set out.)

F. Sign matrix. All signs shall conform to the following requirements:

Subject: AMENDING AMC TITLE 21 - CHURCH AND SCHOOL SIGNS

This proposed ordinance:

Maintains the 20 square foot viewing area for school and church signs if abutting streets not on the official OS&HP (residential streets);


Increases the viewing area for school and church signs from 20 square feet to 50 square feet for signs abutting collector streets or greater;

Allows for one sign per street frontage; and

Allows for school signs to be to be illuminated or lighted.

Approval of this ordinance is recommended.
