AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTIONS 4.05.040 AND 27.20.030 TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONTINUATION OF TERMS FOR BOARD AND COMMISSION MEMBERS PENDING ELECTION OR APPOINTMENT AND CONFIRMATION OF NEW MEMBERS TO FILL VACANCIES.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code section 4.05.040 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4.05.040 Terms.

Except as otherwise specified in this Code, the regular term of each member of a board or commission is three years commencing on February 15 of the year in which appointed and ending three years thereafter on February 14, provided however, the mayor may continue the appointment of members for up to and including 120 days after expiration of their term to avoid a vacancy until new appointments can be made and confirmed. The terms of initial or subsequent appointments to a board or commission shall be staggered so that, as nearly as possible, a pro rata number of its members shall be appointed each year of the established regular term of office.

Section 2. Anchorage Municipal Code section 27.20.030 is hereby amended to read as follows:

27.20.030 Term of office.

The term of each member of a supervisory board established under this chapter shall be three years, provided however, the mayor may continue the service of members for up to and including 120 days after expiration of their term to avoid a vacancy until new members are elected or appointed and confirmed. The terms of members initially appointed or elected to boards established under this chapter shall be staggered so that as nearly as possible a pro rata number of members shall be appointed or elected for each year during the regular term of office established for the members of the board.

Section 3. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage and approval.
