AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 3.87.030 D. TO PROVIDE APPROPRIATE JOB CLASSIFICATION FOR CURRENT PLAN ADMINISTRATOR OF THE POLICE AND FIRE RETIREE MEDICAL FUNDING PROGRAM.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That Section 3.87.030D of the Anchorage Municipal Code is amended by correcting the position description of the Plan Administrator of the Police and Fire Retiree Medical Funding Program. This amendment reads as follows:

3.87.030 Retiree medical funding program trust and program administration

A. – C (No change.)


D. Police and fire retiree medical funding program administration. The Municipality shall fund up to one professional administrative Generalist [TECHNICAL LEVEL EMPLOYEE TO ASSIST IN THE ADMINISTRATION OF] to administer the police and fire retiree Medical funding program. The selection of such employee shall be subject to the approval of the board of trustees, which approval will not be unreasonably withheld.

Section 2. This ordinance is effective immediately upon passage and approval.
