AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE OF REGULATIONS SECTION 21.20.002 TO PROVIDE FOR A NEW FEE FOR A CERTIFICATE OF NONCONFORMING ENCROACHMENT

### THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

<u>Section 1</u>. Anchorage Municipal Code of Regulation section 21.20.002 is hereby amended to read as follows:

# 21.20.002 Schedule of Fees---Zoning.

- A. The following fees shall be paid for the services described:
- Rezoning, conditional use or major amendments to conditional use where the gross site area is:

a.	Less than 1.75 acres	\$500.00		
b.	1.76 to 5.00 acres	750.00		

- c. 5.01 to 40.00 acres 1,000.00
- d. 40.01 acres or more 1,500.00
- 2. Applications for a public hearing before the assembly on a rezoning with an unfavorable recommendation of the planning and zoning commission
- Appeals, application for variance, or change of land use heard by the zoning board of examiners and appeals
- 4. Minor amendments to previously approved conditional uses, including time extensions and site plan changes. If the planning and zoning commission determines that an issue is a major amendment, this fee shall be applied toward the application fee required by paragraph 1 [A.1] of this section

#### **PUBLIC SECTOR ECONOMIC EFFECTS:**

The ordinance amendment will provide for a new fee to implement and help pay the processing fees for a recently enacted amendment of the code allowing for the expedited processing of structural encroachments into required zoning setbacks. There should be no significant public sector economic impact because the public presently has to pay the exact same fee to process public hearing variances to the Zoning Board of Examiners and Appeals

### **PRIVATE SECTOR ECONOMIC EFFECTS:**

Approval of the ordinance amendment should have no significant economic impact on the private sector because the amendment simply provides for a fee to help recover the administrative costs to process Certificates of Nonconforming Encroachments. This fee is the same amount that the public presently pays to process public hearing variances for similar encroachments.
