Pole signs, rotating signs, and flashing signs shall be 19 prohibited. 20 21 WHEREAS, AO 2001-80, including the sign prohibition, was effective immediately 22 upon its passage and approval on May 8, 2001; and 23 24 WHEREAS, the application of the prohibition on certain signs may unduly impact 25 plans, contracts and commitments already made by local businesses; now therefore. 26 27 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS: 28 29 <u>Section 1.</u> The prohibition on certain types of signs in Anchorage Municipal Code 30 subsection 21.50.320M. shall not be effective until June 1, 2002.
