Section 3. Anchorage Municipal Code section 3.30.132 is hereby amended to read as follows:

3.30.132 Shifts.

The following [TWO] types of [REGULAR] shifts are authorized:

- Established shift. A regular shift (e.g., 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. or 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 Α. p.m.) that applies to all employees of a department, division, section or work unit.
- Flex time. A designated period (e.g., 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.) during which employees Β. may choose their own eight-hour periods, with the approval of their agency head.
- Alternate Workweek Shifts. A designated period (e.g. 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.) that may <u>C</u>. exceed an eight-hour work shift under an approved alternate workweek schedule. Alternate shifts are included in such 40-hour workweeks in which the ending or beginning of the shift may be other than midnight Sunday to the following midnight Sunday, such as, but not limited to, shifts that begin on a mid-Friday to accommodate a 9-80 schedule and end the following mid-Friday.

Section 4. Anchorage Municipal Code section 3.30.142 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Holiday falling on Saturday or Sunday. 3.30.142

For employees scheduled to work on a regular Monday through Friday schedule, when a recognized holiday falls on a Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be recognized as the holiday. For these employees, when a recognized holiday falls on a Sunday, the Monday following shall be recognized as the holiday. For employees working other than a regular Monday through Friday schedule, or working an alternate workweek schedule, either the holiday itself or such other day as determined by the agency head will be recognized as the holiday.

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective July 1, 2001 upon its passage and approval by the 32 Assembly.
