Anchorage Municipal Code Section 9.60.120 is hereby amended to read as follows: 18 19 20 9.60.120 **Exemption from taxes.** 21 Α 22 The real and personal property of the authority and its assets, income and receipts are declared to be the property of a political subdivision of the state 23 and, together with any off-street parking facility financed under this 24 chapter, devoted to an essential public and governmental function and 25 purpose, and the property, assets, income, receipts and off-street parking 26 facility shall be exempt from all municipal taxes. 27 28 B Nothing in this section creates a tax exemption with respect to the interest 29 of any business enterprise or other person, other than the authority, in any 30 property, assets, income, receipts or off-street parking facility, whether or 31 not financed under this chapter. 32 33 34 <u>C</u>. However, it is the public policy of the municipality to require the Anchorage Parking Authority as a public corporate authority to make a 35 payment in lieu of taxes for governmental services provided by the 36 municipality, other than those services received by contract between the 37 authority and the municipality. 38 39 The payment in lieu of taxes shall be calculated by applying the millage D. 40 rate established annually for each service area by the assembly to the 41 assessed value of all real property held by the authority. Assessed value 42 will be determined by appraisal using the income method of valuation. The 43
